DECLARING CONTROLLED AND NON-CONTROLLED GOODS IN THE SAME DECLARATION

We are pleased to announce another service improvement effort initiated by the TradeNet Work Improvement Team, whose members comprised of officers from Customs & Excise Department, Trade Development Board, Singapore Network Services Pte Ltd and TradeNet vendors.

2 Currently, for consignments consisting of a mixture of controlled and non-controlled goods, separate permits are required to be declared for the controlled goods. Following feedback received from the trading community, a project was initiated to study possible ways of streamlining the existing work process so as to dispense with this requirement.

3 Effective from 28 Jun 99, traders are no longer required to submit separate declarations for controlled and non-controlled goods imported under the same consignment unless the goods in the consignment fall within the control of more than one Controlling Agency. This facility will apply to all declaration types viz. Joint Customs/TDB declarations, Customs declarations and TDB declarations.
