AFRICAN SWINE FEVER (ASF) DETECTED IN WILD BOAR IN HUNGARY

Hungary reported its first detection of African Swine Fever (ASF) in a dead wild boar found in the Gyöngyös, Heves county.

AVA will impose a temporary restriction on the import of pork and pork products from Hungary due to the detection of ASF, with effect from 24 April 2018. Pork products which comply with the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) guidelines for the inactivation of ASF virus can continue to be exported to Singapore.
